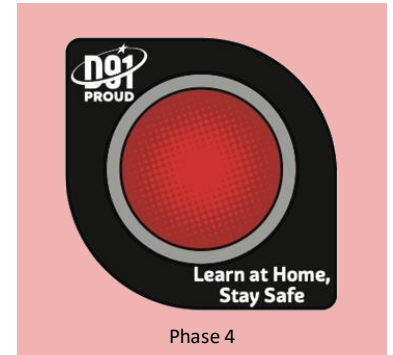
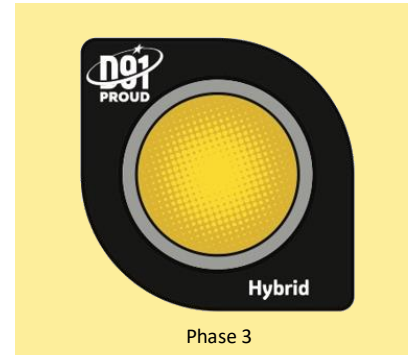
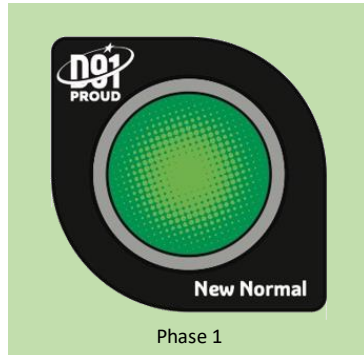

### Classroom Spaces

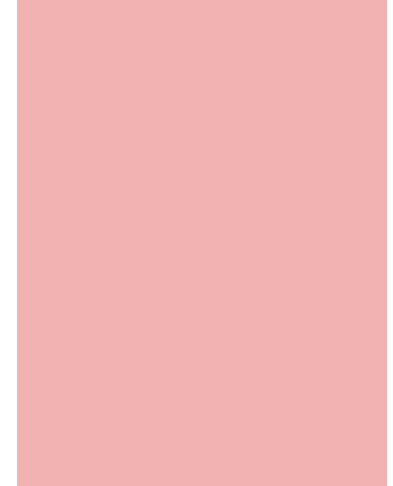

- Classroom materials: Limit use of shared materials. Any common supplies will be sanitized after use.
- Chromebooks: Each student will have their own.
- Visitors: Limit classroom visitors as much as possible.
- LMS: Even if all students are physically in class, the online learning platform will be in full use.

- Visitors: Limit classroom visitors as much as possible.
- LMS: Even if all students are physically in class, the online learning platform will be in full use.

- Fridays will be used for teacher prep, staff development, and may include opportunities for intervention/extension
- Students will work independently to practice concepts that have been previously taught and grow mastery while working at home
- Staff working closely with small groups of students will be encouraged to wear face shields and may instruct students to remove their masks when appropriate and necessary



### Pick Up/Drop Off

- **Drop Off/Pick-Up** - Parents will drop off and pick-up their students at the front of the school building (one lane only). Please pull forward, stay in your car and have students exit/enter the car on the school building side for safety.
- **Kindergarten students:** will come into the cafeteria as soon as they arrive at school to wait for their teacher to pick them up.
- **Doors open:** When the first bell rings. Previously students waited for their teacher in class lines.
- **Masks:** Students should wear masks when on campus.
- **Bus:** Students who ride the bus should wear a mask while on the bus, sit together as a family, social distance

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- **Drop Off/Pick-Up** - Parents will drop off and pick-up their students at the front of the school building (one lane only). Please pull forward, stay in your car and have students exit/enter the car on the school building side for safety.
- Busing: all students are **required** to wear a mask, sit together as a family, social distance when possible, buses will be disinfected between routes
- Parents are encouraged to use the drop off lane
- **Please do not exit your vehicle**
- Staff may assist students entering and exiting vehicles
